The job of the Communion Steward is to procure the bread and juice for Communion, prepare and set up communion on the appointed days (usually the first Sunday of each month, and other occasions like Christmas Eve, Ash Wednesday, Easter, etc.,) and then clean up afterwards, washing dishes used and properly caring for leftovers. Cloth napkins are taken home to wash, press and then returned to church ready for the next time. The expenses incurred may be reimbursed or gift-in-kind with receipts, or simply donated.
