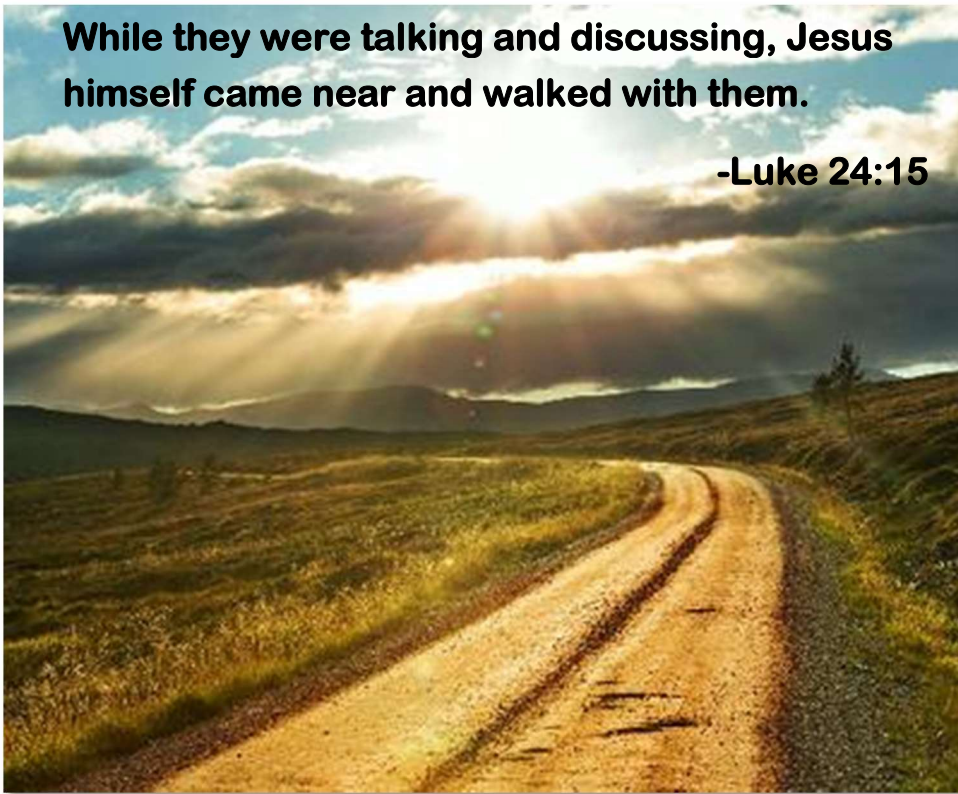


While they were talking and discussing, Jesus himself came near and walked with them.

WALK TO EMMAUS

A Journey with Christ

The Walk to Emmaus begins with a 72-hour retreat that includes 15 talks by lay and clergy on the themes of God's grace, discipleship, and what it means to be the church. The experience is filled with laughter, singing, learning, worship, prayer and reflection. No actual long-distance walking is required, and men and women attend separate events.

During and after the three days, Emmaus leaders encourage participants to meet regularly in small groups to challenge



and support each other in faithful living. Participants describe the experience as one filled with the immense power of God's love and grace. They come away with new insights and a desire to share this experience of Christ with others.
